

Organization: Adopt-A-Legacy International Ministries (ALIM), an affiliate of East-West Ministries International

Partnership model: ALIM provides spiritual care, physical care, and education for at-risk children in Kitale, Kenya, through individual and group sponsorships.

Description: ALIM is a ministry founded by an East-West Ministries missionary in Kitale, Kenya. It provides essentials for at-risk children of all ages. In partnership with an East-West home-based missionary, a local board of nationals directs the work. The children include orphans whose parents have died from HIV/AIDs, children with a surviving parent who is terminally ill and can't work, and abandoned children. Through this program we seek to emulate Christ's example of compassion to the helpless, destitute, and vulnerable. The children are placed within loving Christian homes, rather than an orphan home, to provide as normal an upbringing as possible. They also attend a weekly Bible study, and each one is mentored by a spiritually growing Christian adult. Adopt-A-Legacy has several categories of sponsorship from which a person or group can choose. These include schooling (including tutoring, transport, and uniform), hygiene, food, and meat for the family.
