Discussion and Prayer Guide



Our Heart For You:

You just watched *Where Love Found Me*. Now what? We have an extremely kind and **loving** God who desires to help all those who are orphaned or widowed, alone or distressed. Take some time to discuss and pray for his plans to come about in their lives.

Psalm 34:18 *“The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit.”*

Discussion Questions:

1. What impacted or inspired you? Are you shocked? Hopeful for change? Happy for Ruby?
2. What causes people to do things like traffick children? What is their effect on future generations? How can we stop a vicious cycle?
3. What do you believe about God’s **heart** for the orphan? Read these verses and discuss:

James 1:27 *“Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world.”*

Deuteronomy 10:18 *“He executes justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the sojourner, giving him food and clothing.”*

Psalm 68:5 *“Father of the fatherless and protector of widows is God in his holy habitation.”*

4. What struggles do you face? How do you relate to these kids?

5. How has God rescued you? Provided for you? Shown you **love**?
6. Read these verses and discuss how you can pass on the blessing, comfort, and **love** that God has shown you:

Genesis 12:2 *“And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.”*

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 *“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.”*

Prayer Points:

Before we consider what action steps we can take, let's pause to ask God what to do. Take some time to pray for these children and situations, and ask Him for guidance.

Psalm 37:5 *“Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act.”*

Pray for...

1. Do you know any children who have been abandoned or are in hard situations?
2. Do you know any social workers, parents who have adopted, or anyone involved in caring for children at risk?
3. Have you heard about the conditions for some children around the world and want to see change?
4. Ultimately, pray for salvation for all these people; God's **love** is what changes and strengthens.

Action Steps

1. God gave Moses what he needed to display God's power and rescue His people. Read Exodus 4:1-5 and discuss: What do you have “in your hands” (resources, talents, etc) that God can use on behalf of these children?
2. As you prayed was there any other action steps that God highlighted to you?
