M MOBILIZE

Throughout the year, we seek to expose our community to opportunities to live on Mission and bring awareness to the ways to get involved. One of the ways we do this is through a “Justice & Mercy” weekend in the spring and a “Global Mission” weekend in the fall of each year. During these focused weekends we preach on issues of gospel, justice and mercy and tell stories of people in our church who are involved and invested in these initiatives. For example, we might tell a story of a foster family or a WRAP Around Care Community.

E EQUIP

We then seek to train members of our community on how to live on mission. We do this primarily by inviting them to take their next steps in an Equipping Class that relates to our Justice & Mercy or Global Mission initiatives. We will offer various classes throughout the year like a trauma informed parenting class or a nurture group training for foster and adoptive parents. The goal is to give them a follow-up to the awareness.

S SEND

As people are equipped, we work to empower and launch these members of our community to live on mission in the context of one of our three justice and mercy initiatives: Foster Care and Adoption, Poverty Alleviation, and ending Human Trafficking. We help connect them with organizations and agencies in our city.

S SUPPORT

Finally, we come alongside these individuals and families in partnership to encourage, resource, and support the work God has called them to do. In the context of foster care and adoption, this is accomplished primarily through our Care Communities who wrap around these foster and adoptive families.

M.E.S.S.

Discipleship - the act of following Jesus - can be M.E.S.S.y at times. That's why we're intentional about inviting our people into strategic spaces, equipping them to serve there well, connecting them to the resources they need and supporting them throughout their journey.
